It's hard to believe that we are entering our seventh week of school. Our staff is working diligently to provide your child with a quality education. PARENT/GUARDIAN VISITATION

We want to ensure our students that everyone in the building is accounted for and encourage visitors/volunteers, but need to have record of them in the office prior to visiting the classroom.

TRANSPORTATION (RIDE ARRANGEMENTS)

Please be cognizant of our bell to bell schedule and the importance of not having to disrupt the educational time frame. Please have a plan prior to school involving pick-up arrangements. We realize that emergency situations may occur but we need to be vigilant and have as little disruptions as possible.

SCHOOL HOURS

We need your help! We have no morning supervision prior to 7:35 a.m. on the school grounds. Please remember that school begins at 7:45 a.m. **Please do not drop your child off prior to 7:40 a.m..**

MEDICATION

Students are not allowed to bring any medications to school in accordance with medication laws. If students are in need of medication during school hours parents must pick-up the necessary forms in the office and have them completed by a physician prior to bringing medication to school. **This includes cough drops.**
